

ANDERSON C.V.I. CODE OF CONDUCT

As a student of Anderson C.V.I. you automatically agree to adhere to the code of conduct found in detail in your agenda and in brief outlined below. If you or your parents/guardians have any questions or concerns you are welcome to contact the main office.

A.C.V.I. Code of Conduct:

Each school has the responsibility to develop a Code of Conduct subject to the Education Act and within the guidelines established by the Board of Education.

The goal of the A.C.V.I. Code of Conduct is to maintain a safe, secure and positive learning environment for all Anderson students and staff. It is founded on the belief that this environment is best served when all members of the school community act with self discipline - that is, when members are governed by their individual sense of self-worth and self-respect, and the respect they hold for the dignity and well being of others. We expect all members of the school community to approach school life with personal pride and self-reliance, being always mindful of their relationship with others and with the school environment.

The school Code of Conduct is founded on three essential principles:

- 1. All students and staff have a responsibility to treat members of the school community with **respect, consideration and courtesy.**
- 2. All students and staff have a responsibility to treat school property and the school environment with **pride and care**.
- 3. Behaviour that interferes with the learning and/or the safety and welfare of others is not acceptable.
